Aim of the event: CHARM-EU is excited to announce its second CHARM-EU virtual challenge! All students of the Erasmus Plus Programme are invited to participate. Those interested should complete a registration form and participate in the virtual event that will be held next 15 October 2021 at 12.00 CET. The challenge will be live through the Zoom platform and with the use of the Kahoot! app. The winner of the contest will be announced at the end of the event.

The CHARM-EU Virtual Challenge is a contest designed by the CHARM-EU representative students under the framework of the [#ErasmusDays2021](#). The purpose of this contest is to generate interactions with all participants and exchange knowledge on the CHARM-EU Initiative and the Erasmus Plus Programme.

Here is how it works...

CHARM-EU Initiative is organising a virtual challenge in which participants will have the opportunity to know more about the CHARM-EU initiative and sustainability topics through a live competition. To this end, the CHARM-EU team selected different topics around the initiative and sustainability to work on and created a mix of questions around this.

Instructions to participants:

2. Previous download of Kahoot! app on your mobile (free download from the App Store or Google Play or access through the website: <https://kahoot.it/>)
3. An email for the Zoom link will be sent to all registrants one day before the event.



4. When starting the event on Zoom, the moderator will give you a pin and instructions to access the game on Kahoot!
5. Please add your name (not nickname) to the Kahoot app.
6. **Let the games begin.**
7. The student with the highest number of correct answers will receive a CHARM Green Kit at home*
8. Once the winner is announced, the CHARM-EU team will contact the winner via email in order to send the prize.

* Terms and Conditions: CHARM-EU Virtual Challenge

1. This contest (“Contest”) is organised by CHARM-EU initiative (“organiser”).
2. The official language of the contest is English.
3. Participation in the Contest is subject to the present Terms and Conditions. 4. The topics to be covered by the Challenge are the CHARM-EU Initiative (CHALLENGE-driven, ACCESSIBLE, RESEARCH-based, MOBILE EUROPEAN UNIVERSITY) European Universities, sustainability, green initiatives, the Erasmus Plus programme as well as general knowledge around higher education.
5. This event is organised in the frame of the three days of celebration of the Erasmus+ Programme in Europe(<https://www.erasmusdays.eu/>).



6. **Students from the Erasmus Plus programme countries¹** are eligible to participate and win.
7. The prize will only be delivered inside the territory of the European countries participating in the Erasmus Programme.
8. To enter the competition, please register to the event, providing us with your full name, address, email and phone number. All the submitted data needs to be accurate in order to be eligible to win.
9. During the event, you must have the Kahoot app in your mobile or access through the website: <https://kahoot.it/> and insert your name and the pin provided during the live session.
10. All eligible participants should participate in the live event which will be held on 15 October 2021 at 12.00 CET. Only students that participated in the live challenge are eligible to win.
11. No entries will be accepted after 12.00 CET. Promoter accepts no liability for any connection lost, delayed or damaged in transmission.
12. Registrations to this event can be made from 05 October 2021, 12:00 Central European Time (CET) up until 15 October 2021, 10:00 CET. Registrations received after this time might not be considered.
13. The student that answers more questions correctly in a shortest period of time will be the winner.
14. The winning participant **will be awarded a CHARM-EU Green sustainable kit**. In the event of the prize becoming unavailable, for whatever reason, the organiser reserves the right to provide an alternative prize of equivalent value.
15. There are no cash or credit alternatives available.

16. The name of the winner will be streamed live on the official event by the CHARM-EU moderator.

17. The maximum number of prizes to be awarded are 2.

18. The award - **CHARM-EU Green sustainable kit** - will be sent out to the address provided in the registration form in a period of two months after the contest.

19. In case of a tie with more than two students, the first two participants who answered in a short period of time will win the prize.

20. If more than 2 students answered the correct questions in the same period of time, a virtual draw will take place and the three winners will be informed via email.

21. One registration per person only is permitted in this contest. More than one participation per person – either through the same or another email account – will automatically lead to disqualification of all entries from the competition.

22. The organiser assumes no responsibility for lost or damage on the delivery of the kit.

23. The organiser reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to disqualify and remove any participant that does not comply with these terms and conditions. The organiser also reserves the right to change the judging rules above at any time at its sole discretion, in which case all entrants will be notified via email
