
#### **Cross-Cultural Vision**

### **Innovative Hybrid Spaces**



















## Students collaborating across borders

Through hybrid classrooms, students can engage actively with their fellow students and teachers located at the partner institutions.

So-called 'pods', work stations for a group of students, have hybrid connection facilities of their own. A teaching assistant at each location makes sure everyone is on board and all runs smoothly.
