The CHARM-EU Annual Conference 2025 takes place on 12 November 2025 in Utrecht and online. By highlighting the prominent role of higher education in driving Europe's competitiveness, sustainability and inclusion, the European University Alliance CHARM-EU positions itself as a leading force in shaping strategic responses to societal global challenges by contributing to the transformation of the higher education ecosystem.

Held in Utrecht, the Netherlands, the CHARM-EU Annual Conference 2025 will bring together key opinion leaders, European policymakers, university leaders, innovators, academic staff members and students to discuss how university alliances can contribute to Europe's leadership in professional skills development, talent attraction, mobility, internationalisation and regional development, among others. Through inspiring plenary sessions with top speakers and impactful workshops, this one-day hybrid event will critically examine how the European University alliance model can serve as a driver of European competitiveness.

At a time when Europe is facing multiple challenges, intensifying global competition for talent, and pursuing the dual digital and green transitions, the CHARM-EU Annual Conference 2025 conveys a clear message: universities are not merely institutions of learning — but strategic catalysts for a stronger, more competitive and resilient Europe. This transformation reinforces the strategic role of the European University initiative — a visionary endeavour that must be sustained to secure Europe's academic future.
